

We are delighted that **Fr John King will be licensed as Associate Priest** on 15th May at Barking Lodge by + Lynne Cullens. Fr John King has been signed off from curacy and will be licensed as an associate minister in this parish in a 'domestic' licensing (i.e. at Barking Lodge). This is so this can happen as quickly as possible. We look forward to his continued ministry in the parish and we will be marking this new stage in his ministry on the Eve of Corpus Christi (29th May).

We welcome the announcement that Bishop Saulo Barros is to be the next Priest-in-Charge of our neighbouring parish of St Martin's, Plaistow. All are invited to his licensing at St Martin's on 15th May at 7:30pm. Bishop Saulo has already given considerable service to the parish in the recent months of change and uncertainty following the death of Fr Marco. Please pray for Saulo and Ruth for the next phase of their ministry.

Visitation Service - the Citation for the Visitation is on the noticeboards. The Visitation Service for Newham Deanery will be at All Saints West Ham on Wednesday 19th June 2024 at 7.30pm. Retiring and new church wardens and clergy are cited, that is, they must attend. Everyone else please come if you can to support them.

Thy Kingdom Come: the days between Ascension and Pentecost are designated as a time of prayer for the church, locally, nationally and globally. Some resources will be given out to assist your prayer life should you wish to use them in this period.

In the fifty days of Eastertide we celebrate the joy and new life of the Resurrection. This reaches a conclusion with the great feasts of Ascension Day and Pentecost Sunday. These are followed by Trinity Sunday (our parish feast of title) and Corpus Christi when we give thanks for the sacrament of Holy Communion. At this service there will be a **commissioning of eucharistic ministers**: please do come and receive the prayers of the parish if you administer the chalice in our churches. We will also be celebrating Fr John King's completion of curacy and the start of his new stage of ministry as associate priest.
