- Creating opportunities for conversations about supporting each other in various roles and how to encourage and support new people into these roles, which are often ill-defined.
- Making connections between lay folk in neighbouring Churches.

So we need ideas from YOU as to how we can forward this work.

This means making more contacts. We have a fair number of Church Wardens, alongside Deanery reps but very few Parish Safeguarding Officers and Treasurers, who are particularly isolated with complex responsibilities.
