New electoral roll 2025 If you are baptized, aged 16 or over and have been attending church in our parish for at least six months (or live in the parish) please join the electoral roll by filling in an electoral roll form. This year there is a completely new electoral roll, so if you have been on the roll before you need to fill in a form again. Forms are available in all our churches. Please ask if you need help completing the form. Please return your completed form to electoral roll officer Colin (if you are at St Mary's), Shirley or the wardens (if you are at St Bart's) the clergy (if you are at St Ed's) no later than Easter Day (20 April). The new roll is published on Low Sunday (27 April).

**Lent discipleship course: Heart for Mission** The in-person sessions at St Bart's have now concluded. The last online session is this Tuesday 8 April.

**Confirmation and Baptism** will take place on Sunday 4 May at St Mary's Joint Parish Eucharist at 10am. Please keep our candidates in your prayers.

Congratulations to those who have recently completed safeguarding training. We are very grateful to Sandy Davies, one of our Parish Safeguarding Officers, who delivers training. Sandy writes: Promoting a Safer Church - 'Safeguarding' means the action the Church takes to promote a safer culture in all our churches. Here is East Ham we have been strengthening our safeguarding practice, chiefly by delivering training. The Church of England produces training materials that are a requirement for some roles, such as the PCC, and in recent months we have had 21 people complete 47 modules. This does not include clergy, who have to complete a wider range of safeguarding training. Sixteen people have completed all the training required for their role, and others are in the process of completing theirs. In addition, we have helped two other parishes in their training needs - St Barnabas and St Paul's Burges Road - and next will be St Martin's. This is a marvellous achievement, well done to everyone who has completed these modules.

**Tips on veg growing: come to the Eco-Church garden!** Even if we just have a windowsill or balcony, there are things we can grow to enjoy fresh food on our plate. Get some tips by joining us in the Eco-Church Garden, St Mary's Hall, Norman Road at any or all of our work days (8th & 26th April, 6th May, from 10am). On 26th April the **Conservation Volunteers** ('Green Gym') will also be working in East Ham Nature Reserve, so you could spend some time with each team. 
